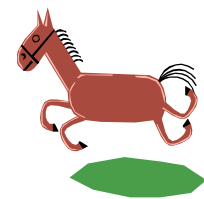

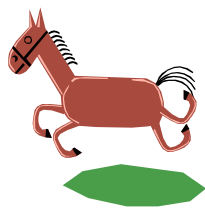
Geranium Sales

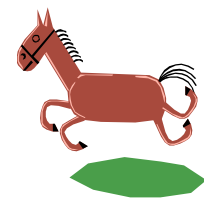
Changes for 2007 –
