

**Hendricks County 4-H Fair
Stall Reservations/Horse & Pony
July 19-25, 2009**

The schedule for arrival and departure is **the same as last year**. Regardless of what discipline you show (contesting, western, english), arrival and departure will be by age division. All seniors (grade 8 through 12) planning to show at the Fair will bring their horses in Sunday afternoon and will be allowed to take them home Wednesday evening. Juniors (grade 3 through 7) will arrive Thursday and will be released Saturday at the conclusion of the show. Exact times will be announced, but all exhibitors need to plan for these arrival and departure dates. **ONLY EXTREME CIRCUMSTANCES WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR DEVIATION AND WILL BE EVALUATED BY THE HORSE & PONY COMMITTEE PRESIDENT, THE FAIRBOARD REPRESENTATIVE AND THE HORSE & PONY SUPERINTENDANT (Bridle Bunch Leader).**
